

What is The Master's Touch?

The Master's Touch is a service ministry of pastoral care provided by both clergy and laity that provides support to people that are elderly, sick, shut-in or otherwise incapacitated. The people served are those who are hospitalized, in nursing homes, or otherwise confined to their own places of residence, and are unable to attend and actively participate in the life of our church.

The purpose of this ministry is to provide the sick and shut-in with a tangible experience of the care and concern of their faith community, while preserving their dignity in their present state.

The service provides them with the opportunity to stay connected to their faith community through active prayer, the ministry of presence, and Holy Communion.

Any member of the Allen Temple AME Church who is in need of pastoral care can receive visits. While this ministry is reserved for members of our church, allowance can be made for the immediate family of members that actively participate in the life of our church to receive visitations.

On specific occasions, and as a form of outreach, we will visit select nursing homes in our area to provide support and offer our services.

How Often Are The Visits?

Persons are visited at least once per month, or as often as is necessary based on the need.
